

## FLOWER ARRANGING MARQUEE

**Judge: Mrs Jane Ellis.** All classes £2 per entry in addition, Class 186: please add £20.00 for resources.

**An Exhibit is composed of natural plant material, with or without accessories.**

**Class 182 Beginners:** “An exhibit using a supermarket bunch.” Space allowed: 50cm wide, 60cm deep, height optional.

**Class 183 Open:** “Welcome to .....!” A circular garland . Please provide loop for hanging. Space allowed: 50cm square.

**Class 184 Open:** “A Botanical Shoe.” An exhibit. Space allowed 35cm square. Preserved plant material may be used.

**Class 185 Novice:** “Inspiration”. An exhibit featuring a Terracotta pot/s. Space allowed: 50cm wide, 60cm deep, 90cm high.

**Class 186 Open imposed:** “Purple Haze.” Resources fee :£20.00. All materials will be provided on arrival. Staging will be at 4.30pm. Own scissors to be used..

**Class 187 Open:** “Curls and Swirls”. An exhibit. height optional. To be staged on round tables 60cm wide. Black drapes. To be judged all round

**Class 188 Open:** “Double Vision”. A floor standing exhibit to be staged by 1 or 2 people. Own base may be used otherwise staged on grass. Space allowed: 120cm wide 120cm deep, 180cm high

***Classes 182,183 & 184** may be brought ready assembled between the staging times or before 8.00am on Saturday. Please inform Julie when they will be delivered. All classes are open to everyone. Competitors will receive one entrance ticket.*

### **Flower Arranging Regulations**

1. All Staging measurements are approximate. Table height is 75cm unless stated otherwise.
2. Staging colours will be **PALE GREEN** unless stated otherwise.
3. All Exhibits must be staged within the space allowed.
4. Exhibits must be staged between 2.00pm and 6.30pm on Friday 29 September, 2017.  
Imposed entrants to stage at 4.30pm.
5. All exhibits and exhibitors' personal property will be at the risk of the exhibitor.
6. Aerosol paints **MUST NOT** be used in the marquee.
7. At the end of staging, competitors must remove all rubbish from the marquee.
8. A beginner is a person who has not entered a competition before.
9. A Novice is a person who has not won a First Prize in a competition.
10. **Judging** to take place Saturday 30 September, 2017 between 8.00am and 10.00am.
11. The Judge's decision will be final.
12. All entries are classed as exhibits and judged according to the NAFAS Competition Manual (2015) 3rd edition.
13. All entries must be on the official entry form.
14. Entries must reach **Mrs Christine Oliver, 13, Dwyer Joyce Close, Histon, CB24 9JZ** by 22nd September 2017.
15. **Prize giving** will be at 4.00pm in the Marquee. 16. Exhibits to be dismantled from 5.15pm Saturday 30 September.
